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Introduction

The Climate Change and Food Security Association (CCFSA) is dedicated to addressing the pressing issues of climate change and food security through collaboration, research, and advocacy. To achieve our mission, we rely on a diverse and engaged membership base. This Membership Policies document outlines the criteria, benefits, responsibilities, and procedures related to membership in the CCFSA.

1. Membership Categories

CCFSA offers several categories of membership to accommodate different levels of involvement and professional backgrounds:

- **Individual Membership:** Open to individuals committed to the mission of CCFSA.
- **Student Membership:** Open to full-time students with an interest in climate change and food security.
- **Institutional Membership:** Open to organizations, institutions, and corporations that support CCFSA's mission.
- **Honorary Membership:** Granted to individuals or entities who have made significant contributions to the field of climate change and food security.

2. Eligibility Criteria

- **Individual Membership:** Individuals who are professionals, researchers, or advocates in fields related to climate change and food security.
- **Student Membership:** Individuals enrolled in a full-time educational program at an accredited institution.
- **Institutional Membership:** Organizations and institutions with a demonstrated commitment to the principles and objectives of CCFSA.
- **Honorary Membership:** Nominations for honorary membership are reviewed and approved by the Board of Directors.

3. Application Process

- **Application Form:** Prospective members must complete an official application form available on the CCFSA website.
- **Supporting Documents:** Depending on the membership category, applicants may be required to submit additional documents, such as proof of enrollment for students or a statement of purpose for institutional members.
- **Review and Approval:** Applications are reviewed by the Membership Committee, and decisions are communicated within [30] days of submission.

4. Membership Dues

- **Compliance with CCFSA Policies:** Members must comply with all CCFSA policies, including the Code of Ethics and Conduct.
- **Active Participation:** Members are encouraged to actively participate in CCFSA activities, committees, and events.
- **Timely Payment of Dues:** Members must ensure timely payment of membership dues to maintain good standing.

7. Membership Renewal

- **Notification:** Members will receive a renewal notice [60] days before the expiration of their current membership term.
- **Renewal Process:** Members must complete the renewal form and submit the annual membership dues by the specified deadline.
- **Lapsed Membership:** Failure to renew membership within [30] days of the expiration date will result in lapsed membership status. Reinstatement requires reapplication and payment of dues.

8. Termination of Membership

- **Voluntary Resignation:** Members may resign by submitting a written notice to the Membership Committee.
- **Non-Payment of Dues:** Membership will be terminated if dues are not paid within the stipulated period.
- **Violation of Policies:** Membership may be revoked by the Board of Directors for violations of CCFSA's policies or Code of Ethics and Conduct.

9. Dispute Resolution

- **Grievance Procedure:** Members may submit grievances or disputes in writing to the Membership Committee.
- **Review Process:** The Membership Committee will review grievances and seek resolution through mediation or other appropriate means.
- **Final Decision:** The Board of Directors holds the final decision on unresolved disputes.

10. Amendments

This Membership Policies document may be amended by the Board of Directors as necessary. Members will be notified of any changes within [30] days of approval.
